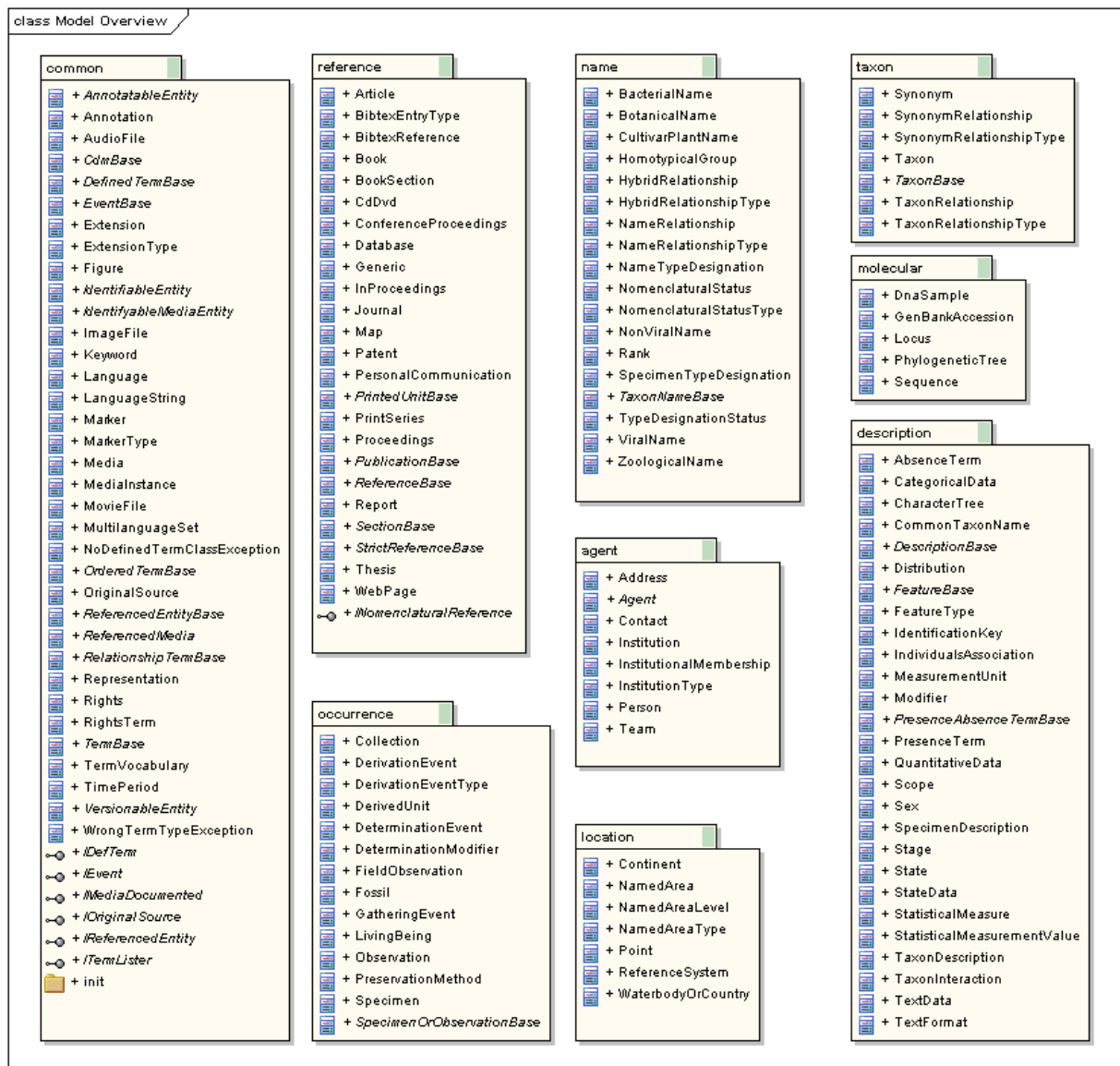


Fig.: Present state of the common data model version 1
